DED#	DATA ELEMENT NAME	FORMAT
SG24	STUDENT-YOUTH-JUSTICE-STATUS	X
This element indicates whether the student is juvenile-justice impacted by identifying if the student has been arrested, detained, or referred to probation as a youth and whether the student was detained during the reporting term.		
A juvenile justice-impacted student is defined as a student who has been arrested, detained, or referred to probation as a youth.		

Coding	Meaning
0	Student is NOT a juvenile justice-impacted youth
1	Student is detained in a county-run juvenile hall
2	Student is detained in a county-run Secure Youth Treatment Facility
3	Student is detained in a county-run juvenile detention camp
4	Student is identified as juvenile justice-impacted (was arrested, detained, or referred to probation as a youth) and is being served by the college on the college's campus
5	Student is identified as juvenile justice-impacted (was arrested, detained, or referred to probation as a youth) and is being served by the college at an alternative, community, or other high school district
6	Student is identified as juvenile justice-impacted (was arrested, detained, or referred to probation as a youth) and is being served at community-based placement, non-profit, or other type of youth residential facility
X	Unknown/unreported
